Accountability is retained by the statutory organisations but they commit to working together through the 'Collaboration Forum'

Other parties (GP practices, voluntary sector and other providers) are accountable to the CCG (or other statutory bodies) via contractual arrangements. We do however need to think about how the Primary Care Board and the Voluntary sector can have tangible input to the development of services and the delivery of the strategy, recognizing this difference in accountability and governance.

The Provider Development Committee has been formed as a committee in common between SFT and YDH. Together with joint execs meetings, this provides oversight to the acute services changes between the two DGHs. This will mitigate the risk of the 'Collaboration Forum' becoming dominated by acute services issues.

The 'Collaboration Forum' will replace the Transformation Board with a purpose to facilitate and support collaborative working amongst providers. One of the key responsibilities will be to ensure that the interactions and dependencies between the work streams are managed.

Membership will be drawn from:

- Workstream leads, which will include provider COOs, DASS and DCS
- Primary Care
- Voluntary sector
- CMOs and Nurse Directors from SFT and YDH
- CCG COO or ANOther
- CEs of SFT and YDH
