

GP Connect Appointments

Booking a patient into a Vaccination appointment within a PCN – EMIS Web




Booking a vaccination appointment— EMIS Web

- Appointments Configuration
 - Select Configuration from the EMIS Ball
 - **Select Organisation Configuration**
 - Select **Organisation Groups** from the navigation pane [towards the bottom of the screen on the left-hand side1
- Search for the Organisation Group that the Vaccination site has created (e.g. C19 Vaccination_QueenswoodYO12AA)
- Check that you are subscribed to the group



Booking a vaccination appointment- EMIS Web

- Making a booking
 - Click EMIS button, point to Appointments, and then select Appointment Book.
 - The Appointment Book screen is displayed.
 - On the ribbon, click Find Slot, and then click Find GP Connect Appointments.
 - The Find GP Connect Appointments screen is displayed.
 - Beside the Patient field, click the magnifying glass and select the required patient using Patient Find






Booking a vaccination appointment— EMIS Web

Making a booking

- Select from the dropdown list the Organisation Group, where you wish to search for appointment slots
- It is mandatory to select at least one organisation group for this functionality to work.
 - Only Organisation Groups you are subscribed to will be displayed
- The Available appointments section is automatically populated with available appointment slots from the chosen Organisation Group
- Select the appointment you want, and then click Book appointment.







Booking a vaccination appointment- EMIS Web

- Making a booking
 - You are only able to search across 14 days.
 - When you select a Search from date, the Search to date is automatically filled out. If you exceed 14 days, an error icon is displayed. The Search From date can be changed
 - When you click Book appointment. The Book Slot screen is displayed.
 - Complete the Description and Comment fields.
 - Click Book.

The Appointment booking screen is displayed.










Viewing a patient's booked appointments

Booking a vaccination appointment— EMIS Web

- Viewing booked appointments
- Click EMIS button, point to Appointments, and then select Appointment Book.
- The Appointment Book screen is displayed.
- On the ribbon, click Patient Appointments, and then select GP Connect Patient Appointments.
- The GP Connect Patient Appointments screen is displayed. Click beside Organisation Group, and select an Organisation Group.
- It is mandatory to select at least one organisation group for this functionality to work.
- In the Patient field, select the required patient using Patient Find.
- Select the Search from date. The default is today's date.
- The Future Appointments and Cancelled Appointments sections are populated





Points to Remember

- The patient needs 2 appointments to be booked
- You can only search for a 2 week period at any given time, to book 2 appointments you need to perform 2 searches
- You may have disabled text reminders for patients; consider reinstating and amending the text tailored to the vaccine clinic
- Wait for the Vaccine site to confirm that they have set up their slots before you try to book
- All sites in the PCN will need to configure their GP Connect system to be able to see your appointments
