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Background

We recognise that our frontline primary care colleagues involved in the delivery of primary care services, both clinical and non-clinical, continue to face many challenges. We have developed three coaching offers for the workforce to access, supporting **psychological wellbeing**, **team development** and **career conversations**.

Our coaches are highly skilled and experienced, and all coaching is free and confidential. The sessions are delivered virtually, preferably via a video platform, but telephone appointments are also available.

Looking After You Too

A support programme was launched on 24 April 2020 at the height of the Coronavirus pandemic, providing individual coaching support for primary care staff.

It's an easy to access, individually tailored coaching service. It's a space for staff to discuss their experiences and challenges and be supported in developing practical strategies.

Sessions are available Mondays to Fridays between 8:00am – 10:00pm and on Saturdays and Sundays between 10:00am – 6:00pm. The first session will last up to 45 minutes.

Looking After Your Team

Launched on 5 January 2021, this coaching offer is available for those who lead, manage or organise a team or group in primary care.

Individuals, and up to two collaborators, get access to tailored support that will focus on proactively supporting them to lead their team or group, and is centred around compassionate and collaborative team leadership.

The aim is to encourage wellbeing and resilience in teams while supporting them to continue to deliver projects, services and high-quality care to patients.

Sessions are available Mondays to Fridays between 8am – 8.15pm and on Saturdays between 10am – 1.30pm. The first session will last up to 60 minutes.

Looking After Your Career

Launched on 18 October 2021.

Individual coaching support is available with a skilled and experienced career coach. The aim of the service is to provide an easy to access, individually tailored career coaching service that focuses on supporting primary care colleagues with their career choices.

The coaching is designed to support people to take practical steps, take more control over their career direction and proactively advance it.

Sessions are available Mondays to Fridays between 8:00am – 8:00pm and on Saturdays between 10:00am – 6:00pm. The first session will last up to 45 minutes.

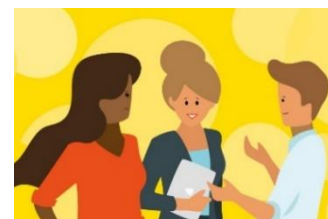

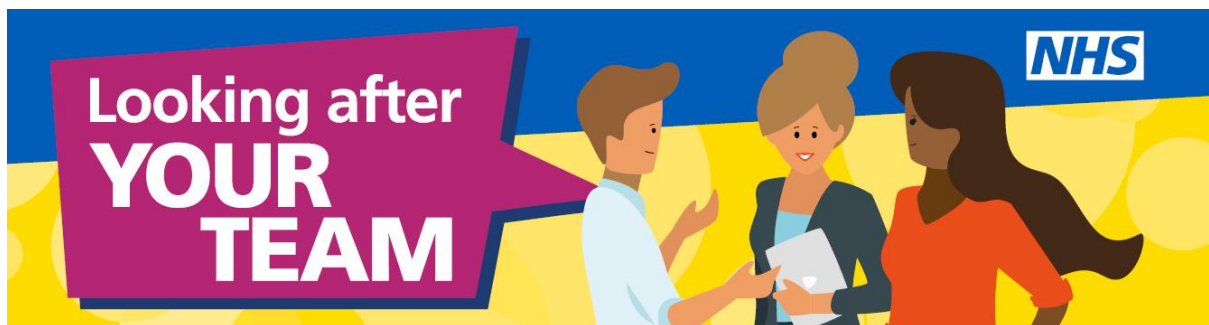
