# GPAS change since last Sitrep

## A quick guide to the GPAS states

	Last Week	This Week	Trend	Note		
West Somerset Coast	<div></div>	<div></div>	↑	Only one practice reporting GREEN, all other practices reporting AMBER	<div>Black</div>	Practice will fail within one month. Urgent system intervention required
Taunton	<div></div>	<div></div>	→	Only 27% practices in GREEN compared to 45% last week	<div>Red</div>	Sustainable in the short term. Needs system support
Mendip	<div></div>	<div></div>	↑	Continuing to show increased pressure	<div>Amber</div>	Sustainable in the medium term 6 months max). Probably needs system support
South Somerset	<div></div>	<div></div>	↑	Practices still reporting pressure from patients and practices	<div>Green</div>	Fully sustainable
Sedgemoor	<div></div>	<div></div>	↑	3 practices reporting Green.
