Having sufficient training numbers for the county is a key factor in sustaining our longer terms ambition for the GP workforce. As you may have heard from recent trainers' meetings, the primary care school are short of places for our doctors in training in Somerset. - Ensure the EOI is no more than 300 words.

All EOIs will be reviewed by the Training Hub and Primary Care School. Those successful at this stage will then be contacted by the ICB primary care team to discuss next steps.
