#### Purpose

Serious violence has been rising in the UK since 2014. Somerset Violence Reduction Unit (VRU) form part of the Home Office's targeted approach to serious violence. The VRU brings together essential partners to reduce local violent crime and address the underlying causes.

You can help prevent violence and build resilience in your service and local communities by following 5 easy steps in this guide:

- Know where to report concerns
- Keep up to date with news
- Train staff
- Share resources with colleagues
- Promote campaigns in the community

This guide can help with staff who work in any organisation that go into people's homes, community settings or public facing services.



### Know where to report concerns

In addition to your own organisations safeguarding procedures also ensure staff are aware of where professionals and the public can report concerns:
