SPH - Pharmacists in Practice - Phase II NHS Pilot - Last Call for Practices to Participate!

SPH will be employing several clinical pharmacists to work in GP surgeries across Somerset from the beginning of 2018. SPH was awarded the contract by NHS England to implement their Phase II Pilot.

Here is an overview of what the scheme is intended to provide:

- Our objective is to introduce more pharmacists to GP practices, working across primary care
 in Somerset. This has two purposes. Firstly to support our practices by extending the clinical
 staff team and the skills and expertise available for non-clinical administrative staff who
 process aspects of prescribing and for patients. Secondly to enable the further improvement
 of clinical effectiveness, safety and quality improvements, reductions in unsustainable GP
 pressures, greater cost-effectiveness and longer term affordability. This will ensure more
 consistent, beneficial clinical services for Somerset patients well into the future.
- The Pharmacists will provide clinical patient facing input, medical governance and management and leadership on pharmacy matters. They will also help support closer liaisons between the practices and community pharmacies and the local residential and care homes.
