New multi-storey car park

The new multi-storey car park is now open. The car park is situated opposite the hospital's main reception and will provide 650 spaces for patients, visitors and staff. Stairs and lifts are available from all floors. Disabled parking spaces are located on the ground floor.

Our new car park is barrier-controlled, and uses pay-on-exit system. Other parts of the hospital site, including the drop-off points outside main reception and outside the Women's Hospital entrance remain monitored by automatic number plate recognition cameras. DIRECTIONS TO YEOVIL DISTRICT HOSPITAL NHS FOUNDATION TRUST

FROM THE SOUTH

Via A37 Dorchester Road – at Quicksilver Roundabout, bear right downhill. At the next roundabout continue straight across in Queensway dual carriageway. At the next roundabout continue straight across into Reckleford. Take the first turning left into Higher Kingston. The main car park is situated opposite the main hospital site.

VIA A3088 TAUNTON

South Petherton - Leave the A303 at the Cartgate roundabout and follow the Cartgate road (approximately six miles) to the roundabout. Take the first exit. At the mini roundabout go straight across to the next roundabout (Crematorium on left). Take the third exit into Preston Road and continue to the next roundabout. Take the third exit into Higher Kingston and the first turning left into Higher Kingston. The main car park is situated opposite the main hospital site.
